Postage and packing are charged extra at cost, but all books are insured in transit free of charge.

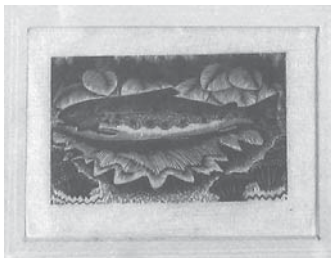
